Most EHR systems were designed for:

- Single-site organizations
- Limited service lines
- Lower operational complexity

Billing becomes disconnected
Leadership loses visibility

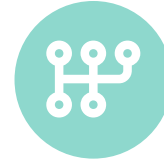
Intake & Access

Challenges: Delays, manual workflows, lack of visibility

Impact: Lost revenue, delayed care, poor experience

"The average wait time for behavioral health services in the U.S. is 48 days from referral to first appointment — and longer for specialized care."

Clinical Workflows

Challenges: Documentation burden, inconsistency

Impact: Burnout, reduced productivity

"More than half of physicians spend over half their workday documenting in the EHR — with only 1 in 4 hours spent face-to-face with patients."

Challenges: Billing delays, denials

Impact: Revenue leakage, cash flow issues

Challenges: Reporting gaps, audit risk

Impact: Compliance risk, poor decision-making
